Mosaic is the art of creating images with an assemblage of small pieces of colored glass, stone, or other materials. It may be a technique of decorative art, an aspect of interior decoration. The earliest known examples of mosaic made of different materials were found at a temple building in Mesopotamia, Ubaid, and are dated to the second half of 3rd millennium BC. They consist of pieces of colored stones, shells and ivory .

It is important that you follow these steps for easy application of CUBE MOSAIC. Our team can also provide you with technical support and information for the application of your tiles. We recommended that a qualified applicator be used for the application of CUBE MOSAIC.



Step 1. Preparing the surface

The surface to be tiled must ne clean, smooth and clear of dust. It must be in plumb and should be dry.



Step 2. Applying the adhesive

Apply a good quality latex-modified thinset approved for use with mosaic tiles. Be sure to use a thinset that is compatible with your substrate and environment. The adhesive should be thick enough to avoid the mosaic sheets from slipping once placed on the wall using the straight edge of the trowel. With the toothed edge of the trowel, comb the adhesive through.



Step 3. Applying CUBE MOSAIC

Apply CUBE MOSAIC sheets with the paper side facing up. Press the sheets firmly in one direction. Using a rubber float, tap the sheets. A wooden float may also be used but never a metal one. Check that all sheets are placed at the exact same distance from each other as the tiles.



After the mosaics have started to set, but before they become fully bonded the paper should be removed. Use a damp sponge on the surface of the sheets to ensure easy removal of the paper. Remove the paper carefully by pulling one corner of the paper diagonally across the sheet. This must be done gently to ensure that no tiles are dislodged in the process. Realign any tiles with a spatula and remove excess adhesive at this point. Let the adhesive dry for approximately 24 hours before beginning the grouting process.



Step 4. Grouting

Use a sponge and warm water to remove any excess adhesive on the sheets. The surface must be free from dust. Using a hard rubber float, spread the grout horizontally and vertically on the mosaic sheets. Cover an area of not more than 2 Sq.mtr. at a time. Remove any excess grout float by working diagonally across the mosaics. After grouting, wait approximately 20 minutes before cleaning the excess grout.



Important

Allow tile work for exterior application or in areas subject to prolonged water immersion such as pools, fountain, spa, etc. to cure for 20 days before exposing to immersion.
